Academic Procedure

Admission

Admission is open to all boys and girls irrespective of caste, creed or social status, who are mentally and physically fit. For admission and registration :-

1. Application shall be made on the specified admission form which is available at the school office. Seats are limited. No student is admitted without an interview/test conducted by the school. Age limit for various classes is :
 - a) Nursery : 3+
 - b) K.G. { LKG : 4+
UKG : 4+
 - c) 1st standard : 5+
2. Student migrating from other school must submit school leaving certificate (SLC) and Progress Report from the previous school, and these certificates must be countersigned by the Regional Officer, CBSE/Deputy Director of Education.
3. At the time of admission, the parents are required to submit the proof of date of birth of their child from the Registrar of Birth/Municipal Corporation/concerned Panchayat/First Class Executive Magistrate. An affidavit regarding date of birth shall not be excepted. For the students migrating from other schools, the date of birth shown in their school leaving certificate will be considered.

Withdrawal

1. If a child is withdrawn during the academic session, a prior one month notice in writing for the withdrawal of day scholar must be given, failing which fee for the said period will be charged. In case of withdrawing a boarder from the school, a prior three months notice must be given, failing which fee for the said period will be charged.
2. Transfer Certificate (T.C.) shall only be given on the receipt of written application from the parents/guardian. A minimum of 24 hours shall be required for the issue of T.C. provided all dues of the school are settled before it.
3. Annual dues are payable if the child is withdrawn at any time from the beginning of the academic session.

School Uniform

The student shall wear the prescribed uniform. All students shall wear School Tie, the Badge, Black Shoes with laces and School Belt.

The other items are :



FOR BOYS :

Dark grey trousers, Grey shirt, Dark grey socks with Navy Blue strip, Plain knitted 'V' necked Navy Blue pullover (with grey stripes and School Insignia), Navy Blue blazer (double breast) with School insignia & Grey turban (for Sikh students).

FOR GIRLS :

Dark grey skirt, Grey shirt, Dark grey stockings with Navy Blue strip, Black ribbon, Plain knitted 'V' necked Navy Blue pullover (with Grey stripes and School Insignia) and Navy Blue blazer (double breast) with school insignia. The uniform for Every Saturday, all students will wear school track suit.

NOTE : Wearing the blazer is compulsory in all school functions held within or outside school campus.



Pedagogy ?

The courses of study is planned to lead upto the 'All India Senior School Certificate Examination' at the end of XIIth standard. The medium of instruction is English.

There are three streams for +2 and a student can opt for five subjects and any additional subject as per his/her interest :

1. Science Stream : English (Core), Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics/ Physical Education/Economics/Web Application.
2. Commerce Stream : English (Core), Business Studies, Accountancy, Economics, Mathematics/Physical Education/Web Application.
3. Arts Stream : English Core, Economics, History, Political Science, Hindi, Sociology, Physical Education/ Mathematics/ Web Application.

Fee Structure

A student shall have to pay the tuition fee and annual charges for the academic session (March to February). Annual charges shall be taken once in a year during the academic session. These charges are taken for the development of library, laboratories, promotion of sports, for health care & Medical check-up of students, and for conducting examinations and organising various activities. A student has to pay admission fee once only.

Note : i) Tuition fee, annual charges & hostel fees are subject to modifications and the details shall be provided to the student at the time of admission.

ii) Fee and annual charges once paid are not refundable.

iii) No security amount is charged.

School Session

In accordance with the Central Board of Secondary Education, the school observes the academic session from March to February.

1st term March to last week of June/first week of July.

2nd term July to last week of November /first week of December.

For Board Examination : As per CBSE Examination schedule.

School Hours

1. Nursery & K.G. : 8.45 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.

2. Class I to Class XII : 8.45 a.m. to 2.45 p.m.

Visiting Hours

The Principal receives visitors on all working days between : 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. Parents can meet the class teachers only on the last working Saturday between 11.00 a.m. and 1.00 p.m. Kindly adhere to the visiting hours to avoid disappointment. In case of emergency, appointment with the Principal may be arranged through the school office.

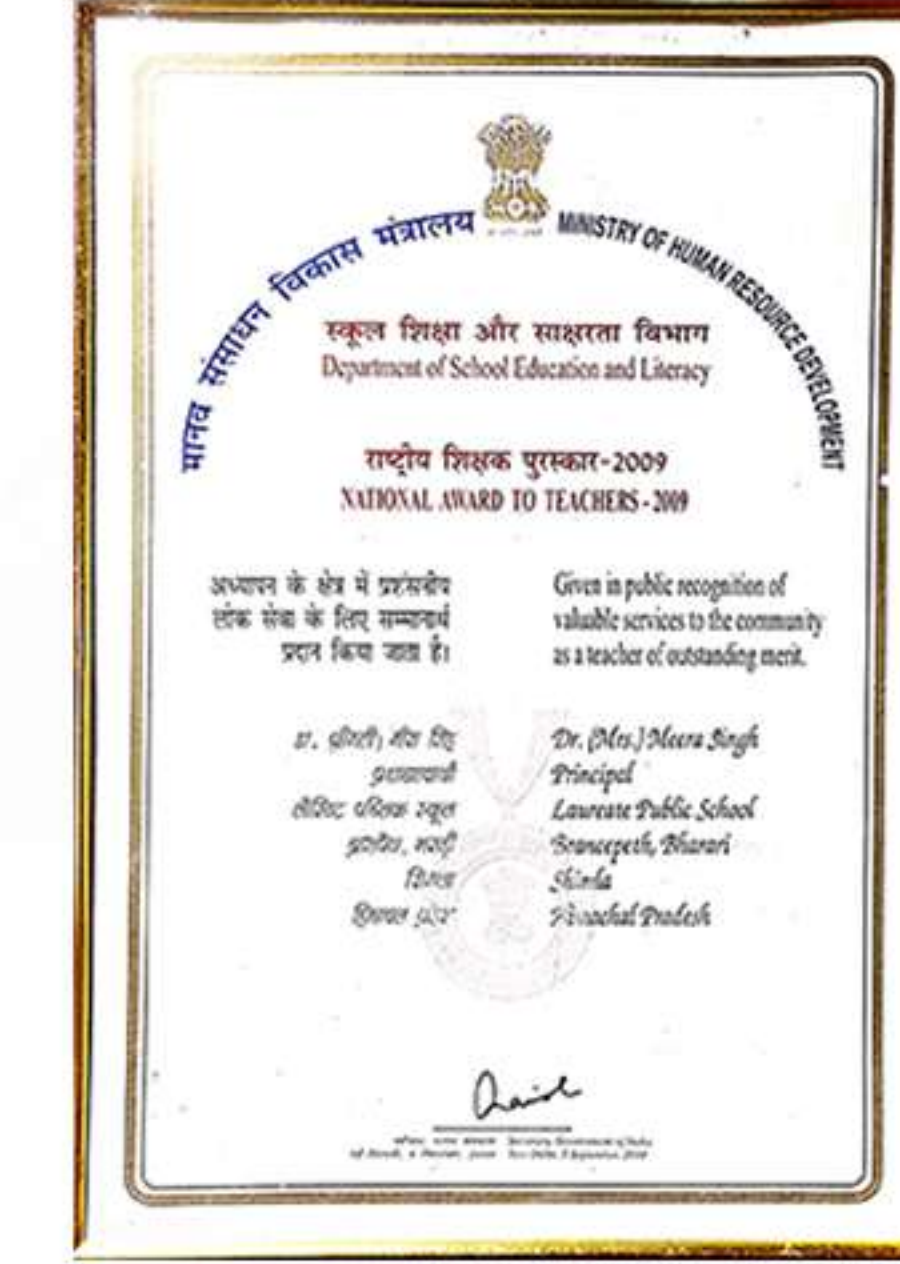
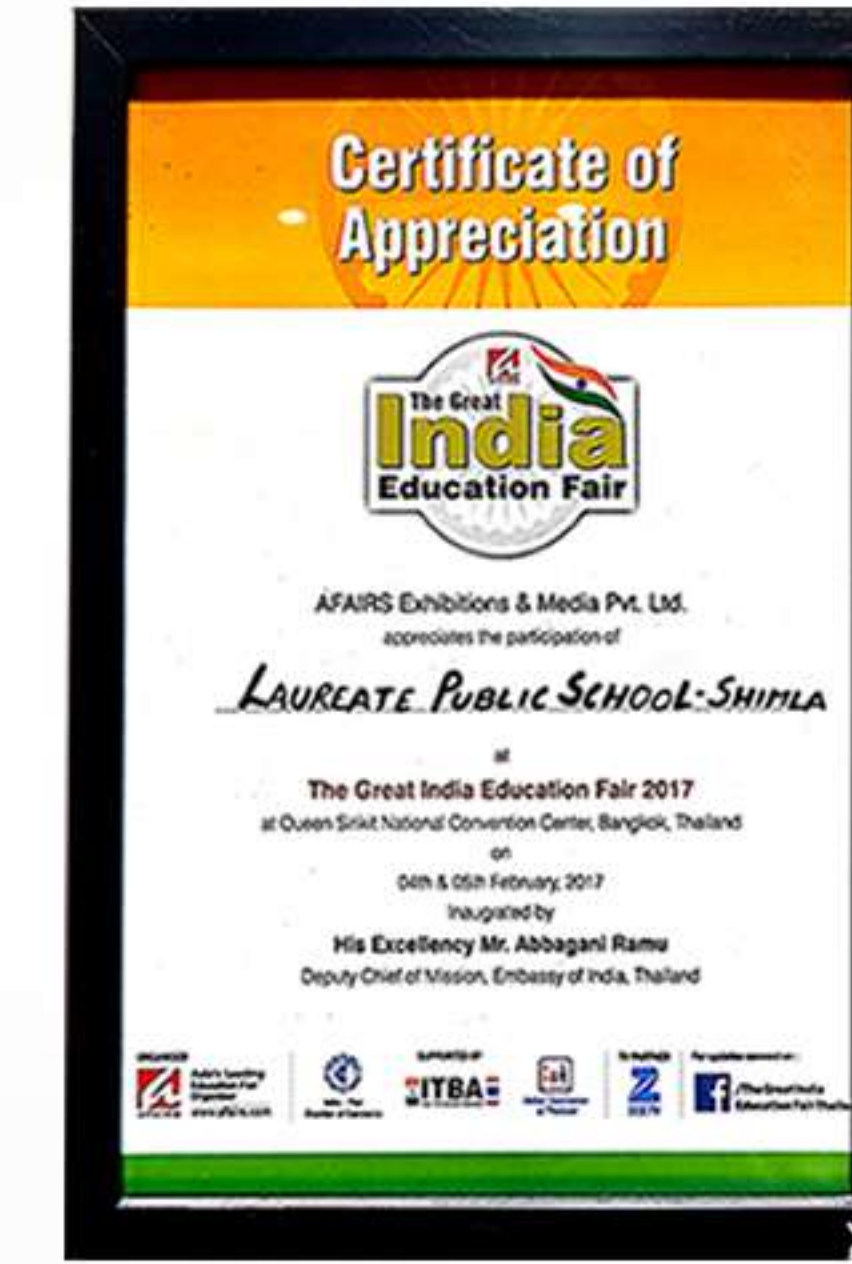

Rules & Regulations

The following rules and regulations have been framed with a view to ensure smooth academic work in the school campus, and mainly to enable the parents/guardians to observe the norms so that no untoward and avoidable hindrance is caused to distrust the normal academic routine.

- 01. The school begins with the morning assembly and a student shall reach the school premises five minutes before the commencement of the assembly.
- 02. No student shall absent without previous sanction of the leave . An absentee on return to the school shall give an application containing convincing reasons in black and white for his/her absence from the school. If a student absents for more than seven days, then his/her name shall be struck off the school rolls.
- 03. No student shall leave the school premises during the school hours. A student shall not take shortleave or half leave. A student shall not attend school wearing gold/silver chains/ornaments or heavy ‘Kara’.
- 04. A student shall be habitually clean and always neatly dressed . The complete school uniform shall be worn on all school! days.
- 05. A student shall not damage school property . Any denieoe to the property , by accident or by chance , shall be reported without delay to the Class Teacher/ Principal. In such cases , penalty can be imposed on the defaulter.
- 06. A student shall not explode crackers or play with fireworks , use transistors / walkman or spill Holi colours within school premises. A student shall get the progress report book signed by their parents / guardian within the prescribed duration.
- 07. A student shall not receive visitors without prior permission of the school Principal. No books (other than text or library books) and magazines shall be brought to the school.
- 08. Parents and guardians are not allowed to walk into the classroom or approach the teachers during school hours. They shall contact the Principal during the appointed hours in case of any problem.
- 09. If a student does not improve his/her conduct inspite of repeated warnings , then his/ her name shall be struck off the school rolls. Any abnormal tendency noted in a student at home may also be brought to the notice of the school authorities.
- 10. All students must try to speak in English within the school premises. Chewing gumis totally banned in the school campus/school buses for children of all ages & giving gifts/tips to the members of staff at all levels is not encouraged. The school diary is to be brought to the school daily and shall be maintained properly. The parents/authorized guardian must sign the school diary daily.
- 11. A student shall attend all school functions and take part in extra-curricular activities. The list of such activities shall be supplied to the students in the beginning of academic session. The school may impose a fine of Rs. 100 per absence in the activities.
- 12. A student shall pay the school fees by the stipulated time mentioned in the fee book. All students (Day scholars as well as Boarders) have to clear their dues and fees on or before 10th November. Delayed payments / non-payments of dues may lead to debarring from examinations/withholding of results/ cancellation of enrollment.
- 13. The school shall not be responsible for any serious mishap/casualty which may take place by chance although every care will be taken by the school authorities/hostel warden to prevent such mishap. The school reserves the right to take decision with regard to emergency medical situations including surgery when the consent of the parents/ guardian cannot be obtained in time.
- 14. After long/short break (Holidays) , the Boarders should report to the hostel warden on the working days between 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. otherwise the students and their parents will not be attended.
- 15. The students are not allowed to keep the Mobile Phones. The use of Mobile Phones in hostel and classrooms is strictly prohibited. In case of emergency, if a student brings his mobile phone to the school then he/she should hand over to the class ipachenieatdan and can take back when it is needed for emergent call.
